



ENG Furniture Foil Application Instructions

What are furniture foils made of?

Furniture foils are made of high-quality matte monomeric film, which is self-adhesive, allowing for easy installation without glue and enabling you to cut and fit it to almost any flat surface.

Installation instructions

Wet Application Method:

1. Prepare a spray bottle with water.
2. Thoroughly clean the surface where the foil will be applied – remove dust, dirt, and any other impurities.
3. Adjust the foil to the surface with the printed side facing up. If necessary, trim it with scissors or a utility knife.
4. Generously spray the surface where the foil will be attached with water.
5. Peel back approximately 5–10 cm of the backing paper and spray the adhesive side of the foil with water.
6. Attach the exposed part of the foil, smoothing it with a squeegee to push out air and water bubbles.
7. Continue peeling off the backing paper, spraying the adhesive side of the foil with water, and attach it while smoothing with the squeegee.
8. Once finished, remove all air bubbles and dry the surface with a towel.

Dry Application Method:

1. Thoroughly clean the surface where the foil will be applied – remove dust and greasy stains.
2. If applying the foil on a vertical surface, start from the top. For horizontal surfaces, it doesn't matter which side you start from.
3. Unroll the foil on a clean, dry surface with the printed side facing up and check its quality.
4. Place the foil on the surface, peel back approximately 20 cm of the backing paper, and fold it under.
5. Smooth the applied section with a squeegee, pushing out air bubbles as you go.
6. Finally, smooth the entire foil with the squeegee to remove all remaining air bubbles.

How to clean the foil?

For regular cleaning, a slightly damp cloth with a mild detergent is sufficient. After cleaning the foil, wipe it with a dry cloth to remove excess moisture and prevent possible peeling.

IMPORTANT! Follow safety precautions when using the product.

Do not place the product in areas exposed to direct contact with fire. Keep out of reach of children – risk of swallowing small parts or protective film. In case of material damage (e.g., tears, cracks), stop using the product immediately and dispose of it safely. Dispose of the product after use in accordance with local regulations for plastic materials. Failure to follow these recommendations may result in damage to the product or personal injury.
